HOW TO GET TO PARK VETERINARY HOSPITAL AND HOPE VALLEY VETERINARY CLINIC

Park Veterinary Hospital is situated at 24 Abbeydale Road South, Sheffield S7 2QN, opposite the main car park entrance to Millhouses Park and is well served by bus routes which pass by it.

Hope Valley Veterinary Clinic is situated at Hathersage Parish Rooms, Main road, Hathersage, S32 1BB. The clinic is well served by bus routes which pass it.

CAR PARKING

There is excellent parking all around Park Veterinary Hospital and Hope Valley Veterinary Clinic.

For Park Veterinary Hospital, Abbeydale Road South parking restrictions apply, directly in front of the practice, between 8am to 9.30am.

For Hope Valley veterinary Clinic, Hathersage has on road parking bays. There is a time restriction of 40 minutes on these bays.

APPOINTMENTS

There is an appointment system although urgent cases are seen at any time. We try to ensure that patients are seen at their appointed time but on occasions there may be unavoidable delays. If such a situation arises the staff will keep you informed of progress.

Before leaving the surgery please arrange any appointments, requested by the veterinary surgeon, at reception. If you need a special time please inform reception - they will do their best to help.

If for any reason you are unable to keep your pet's appointment please telephone and let us know as soon as possible so that your appointment can be re-scheduled and your original appointment re-allocated.

About Us

Park Veterinary Hospital is the only Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons (RCVS) accredited Hospital who provide their own 24hour care on site in Sheffield. We have a range of specialist equipment including ECG, ultrasound, video endoscopy, digital imaging and dental X-ray. We have met rigorous standards set by the RCVS throughout the hospital.

The hospital is also a training centre for veterinary nurses and a training practice for veterinary undergraduates. A full range of medical and surgical treatments and care are available through the hospital.

Hope Valley Veterinary Clinic is a branch of Park Veterinary Hospital. It is accredited to the RCVS Core Standards. A full range of small animal medical treatments and minor procedures are available at Hope Valley Veterinary Clinic but all investigative work and surgery will be carries out at Park Veterinary Hospital.

SURGICAL WORK

At Park Veterinary Hospital there are fully equipped surgical, digital imaging and dental suites. Pre-operative and postoperative guide lines are always given. Approximate estimates will be given for treatment, upon request.

INVESTIGATIVE WORK

At Park Veterinary Hospital there is a well equipped laboratory. This gives rapid diagnostic information for routine and urgent cases. External laboratories are often used for specialist testing. Occasionally the services of veterinarian specialists may be sought by referral..

REPEAT MEDICATION

We request 24 hours notice for repeat prescriptions and medications. Please ring and speak to reception about your requirements. On occasions you will be required to bring your pet for a check to ensure that the treatment is still appropriate – this will be determined by the veterinary surgeon in charge of the case.

PAYMENT & PET INSURANCE

Payment for clinical work is requested at the time of treatment. We support the principle of pet health insurance. If you have a claim it will need to be completed by a veterinary surgeon. Please allow a minimum of 2 weeks for preparation.

The Pet Healthcare Plan

To enable pet owners to spread the cost of routine treatment and qualify for additional discounts on other items in the practice, we have designed our own practice membership scheme – The Pet Healthcare Plan.

*For cats and dogs flea and tick treatment can be monthly or quarterly (6 months worth dispensed twice a year). For lungworm prevention in dogs (up to 45Kg) monthly treatment is required. For rabbits 6 doses of endo- & ecto- parasitic treatment available per year (this is enough for 6 treatments in rabbits <2.25Kg).

**Twice yearly tapeworm treatment if on monthly flea/lick treatment. Quarterly worming if on quarterly flea/lick treatment (dispensed in two dispenses throughout the year). For rabbits 6 doses of endo-& ecto- parasitic treatment available per year (this is enough for 6 treatments in rabbits <2.25Kg).
